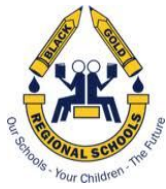
PD Goal:

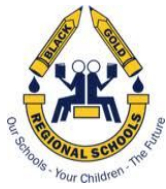
Division 1 and 2 lead teachers will facilitate the session for their colleagues in order to standardize assessment and reporting.

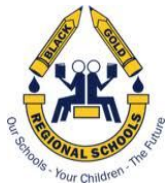
