## **Accountability Pillar Surveys**

This month, parents and guardians of BGRD students may receive a package from Alberta Education containing the Accountability Pillar survey.

Alberta Education will be conducting the annual Accountability Pillar Survey from January to the end of February.

- <u>In January</u>, parents of students in grades 4 & 7 will receive a survey from Alberta Education.
- <u>In February</u>, <u>students</u> in grades 4 & 7 and <u>all teachers</u> will be completing their surveys online at school.

The Accountability Pillar survey will ask you questions about your experience with your child's school. In addition to English and French, the parent survey is available in Chinese, Punjabi, Arabic, Blackfoot, Dene, Cree, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Urdu.

When filling out the survey, if you don't know the answer to a question, simply leave it blank and go to the next question. All responses are anonymous. The results are compiled by Alberta Education and shared with BGRD to assess satisfaction with the quality of education in its schools and to find ways to improve teaching and learning for all our children.

You may fill out the survey online or using the paper copy provided in the package you receive. All responses must be completed online or sent in by February 28, 2020.

Thank you for taking the time to fill out the survey – your voice matters.

## Planning Ahead:
